All IST graduates receive a High School Diploma that is recognized throughout the world similar to those earned in western countries. Students who wish to pursue higher levels of achievement can complete the IST Diploma as well as IB Course certificates in courses offered. These certificates can often be applied for credit in selected colleges and universities and are internationally recognized. Students who wish to pursue their academics to the fullest can complete the IST Diploma and the complete IB Diploma Programme (IBDP) including the core, TOK, CAS and EE. The IB Diploma Programme is the world's premiere secondary qualification.
