I also hope that everyone enjoyed the summer break and feels well rested and ready for the busy year ahead.

Ms. Derwish Absence

Unfortunately I need to begin the first edition of Blaze with a little sad news. New IST ELA teacher, Sara Derwish, was last week diagnosed with a serious ailment that has required that she return to Sweden yesterday to undertake urgent medical treatment. At this time we do not know exactly how long Ms. Derwish will need for her convalescence, but I want to assure parents that we have a plan and the staffing to ensure that the programme is not negatively impacted by her absence. I know that you will join me in extending our community's best wishes to Ms. Derwish for a speedy recovery.

Judging the Quality of a School

There are many ways in which adults and students judge the quality of a school, including facilities, playgrounds (!), student and staff demographics, friendships, range and quality of events and activities, home and school communication, the general tone of community relationships, university acceptances, and most importantly for schools, the quality of learning. Unfortunately, not all learning is necessarily immediately evident, especially when we consider dispositional learning, such as are expressed in IST's learner outcomes, with dispositions like as being friendly, inquirers, thinkers, and principled being difficult to quantify. That said, all of us are able to make observations about our children's learning progress at school, and typically we expect to see positive development in both disposition and academics.

IB Diploma Results

At IST we use a range of assessment tools and methods to gauge student learning and achievement; however, the most obvious and objective of these tends to be the performance of our Senior students in their **IB Diploma examinations** when compared to other students around the world. IST has a very proud history of exceptional results, and I am delighted to share the news that once again our graduating students have performed exceptionally well and IST continues to be rated as one of the top 10 IB schools in China (out of 160+ schools) and top 100 in the world (out of over 3000 schools). These results provide parents of children at all grade levels with objective feedback and perspective on the cumulative value of IST's learning programmes, from KG1 all the way through until Grade 12. Here are some highlights:



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Outstanding IB Diploma Examination Results

- 100% pass rate
- Henny Lee: Perfect 45/45 (Only 1 student in 500 achieves a 45!)
- Average score of 35.5 points (vs World average of 30.2)
- 88% of students \geq World average
- 36% of students > gold standard of 40 points (vs World average if 8.6%)
- 64% of students earned bilingual diplomas
- Congratulations to the entire Class of 2023 on their outstanding examination success!

Schoolwide Goal

Allied to our focus on dispositional learning (which includes cognitive-academic dimensions) is **IST's yearly commitment to a school-wide goal** that we like all members of our community to actively embrace and promote. This year IST teachers, staff and students (and hopefully parents too!) will pay special attention to the IST learner disposition of being 'knowledgeable', with a focus on the diversity of knowledge and the diversity of thought. I encourage you to discuss this year's goal with your children, and to model for them your own commitment to learning, knowing, and sincere intellectual inquiry.

Facility Upgrades

One of the first things to strike visitors to our school is the exceptional quality of our facilities and learning resources; IST really is one of the most beautiful and best equipped international schools in China (and the world!) and without question the very best in Tianjin. Every year the IST Board of Governors seeks to make additional improvements to our school in an effort to further advance our mission of providing an outstanding education and educational learning environment for our students, and additional upgrades were therefore made to the campus this summer that I am sure you will agree have really enhanced the appearance and functionality of our school. Projects included

- Upgrade to the Qin foyer and Elementary Office
- Completion of the re-tiling of the Han Building, including the administrative office corridor and main foyer, stairs, and third floor (science) corridors

- Additional XR (AR/VR) immersive learning laboratory in the Han Building (with additional headsets!)
- New IT file storage system and replacement of old voltage transformer
- General touch-ups painting and repairs
- Lots of new furniture
- A few photos for your reference!



After School Play and Parental Supervision

As you are aware, IST belongs to our community and we therefore like to make our facilities and grounds as open as possible to community members, including after school. We must, nevertheless, have certain supervision expectations and ask that parents please adhere to these guidelines:

- **Children are allowed to play at school until 5PM** (in the rear outside playgrounds and sports fields only), so long as they are directly supervised by one of their parents (but not their aiyis);

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- Children may not play outside if unsupervised (and this is especially true in our playgrounds!);
- Students and parents are asked to exit the school buildings by 3:30PM (2:30PM on Wednesdays).
- Families can remain in the Parent Lounge until 4:30PM, however, children are not permitted to play inside the building and are required to be supervised and engaged in quiet activities if they are in the lounge with their parents, (e.g., reading or homework). If children wish to play, they need to be taken outside to do so.

Evacuation Practice

As part of our community safeguarding efforts, we carry out routine evacuation drills. Yesterday morning we practiced a fire drill, and I am delighted to report that the conduct of students and adults was exemplary. The entire school was evacuated and registered in less than five minutes (always our goal). I am regularly involved in the evaluation of other schools, and one area that I know we excel in, is the quality of our evacuation protocols and behavior; yesterday's drill really was something to be proud of!

IST Publications

All new families should have by now received a welcome packet containing a hard copy of the Parent-Student Handbook, and all families should have received a hard copy of the annual Calendar. All families in the school last year should also have received their hardcopy of the 2022-23 International^{IST} yearbook, but if not, please ask for your copy at one of the administrative offices. Again, it is my great pleasure to welcome you all to the new school year. Please remember that our doors are always open.

Welcome back!

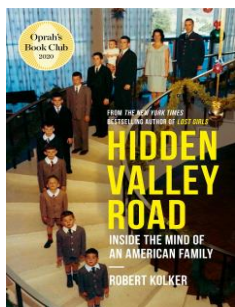

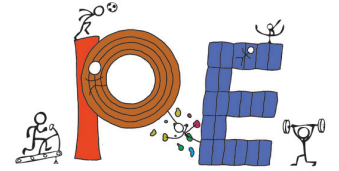
Parent Book Club – Tuesday, Sept. 5th @ 8:30am in the library
